We are delighted to welcome you to our campsite!

In order to ensure that all guests feel equally at ease, the following rules must be followed:

- Quiet hours are from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m. All guests are asked to behave in such a way that other people are not disturbed (e.g. by turning off their music).
- All fires must be extinguished after 11 p.m. (applies to the whole campsite and the sunbathing lawn; public barbecue areas and guests' own barbecues, etc.)
- Sunbathing lawn: it is strictly prohibited to be in the lake or on the bathing jetty after 11 p.m.
- Minors under the age of 16 must be with their parents/legal guardians or be within eyeshot of them after 11 p.m.
- Open fires and lighting fireworks are not permitted anywhere on the campsite (not even on 1 August which is Swiss National Day!).
- Check-out for camper vans/caravans/tents is at 12 noon. Check-out for barrel-shaped cabins/rooms is at 10 a.m. A fee will be charged if check-out times are not adhered to.

In principle, we request advance payment!

- Motor vehicles may not enter the touring site after 10 p.m. Any such vehicles must be parked in the "Wannenbrett" car park. Tickets for the car park
- All vehicles (cars, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, scooters, etc.) may only be driven/ridden at a walking pace on the whole campsite.
- All rubbish must be put into official Müve bags and deposited at the designated collection points (rubbish bags can be purchased at reception).
- Dogs must be kept on a lead on the campsite (attention: a strict dog ban is enforced on the sunbathing lawn!).
- It is prohibited for anyone under the age of 16 to consume alcohol on the whole campsite. Any violations will result in a ban from our campsite and will be reported to the police if necessary.
- Alcohol consumption must be age-appropriate (16 to 17-year-olds may only drink low-percentage alcohol like beer and wine). Carrying and/or consuming stronger alcohol will result in a ban from our campsite and will be reported to the police if necessary.
- Anyone who disturbs other guests by consuming excessive amounts of alcohol (no matter what their age!) may be expelled from our campsite.
- Consuming and carrying any illegal drugs is strictly prohibited on the campsite.
- Not adhering to the campsite rules may result in immediate expulsion by our entire campsite team and our on-site security service.

Depending on the severity of the incident, the police will be called for assistance and an official report will be made to them.
